



Pyramids of Giza. The Great Pyramid of Giza is a defining







symbol of Egypt and the last of the ancient






Seven Wonders of the World. It is located on the Giza

were built from roughly 2550 to 2490 B.C. The














Pharaohs Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure. Khufu's pyramid is
