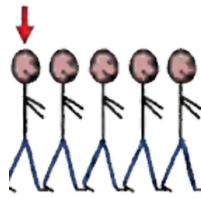

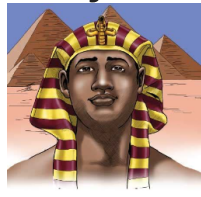
symbol of Egypt and the last of the ancient



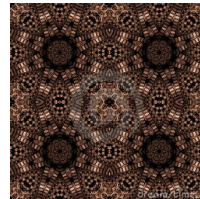
Seven Wonders of the World. It is located on the Giza



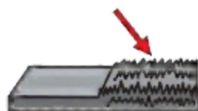
plateau near the city of Cairo and was built



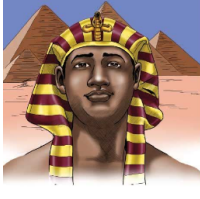
during the reign of the pharaoh Khufu. All three of
