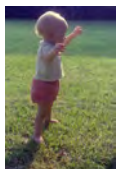

A baby needs air.

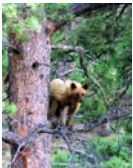


A doll is non-living.

A teddy bear is non-living.

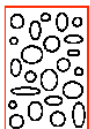




An elephant is living.



An elephant eats food

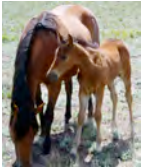
