help us understand the past.



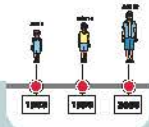
Artifacts are things from the past that people made. Clothes, jewelry,

any more. Lastly, soldiers went to Texas to tell slaves about Lincoln's letter.



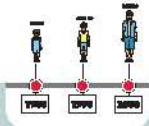
It was important that all people knew about their freedom.
