

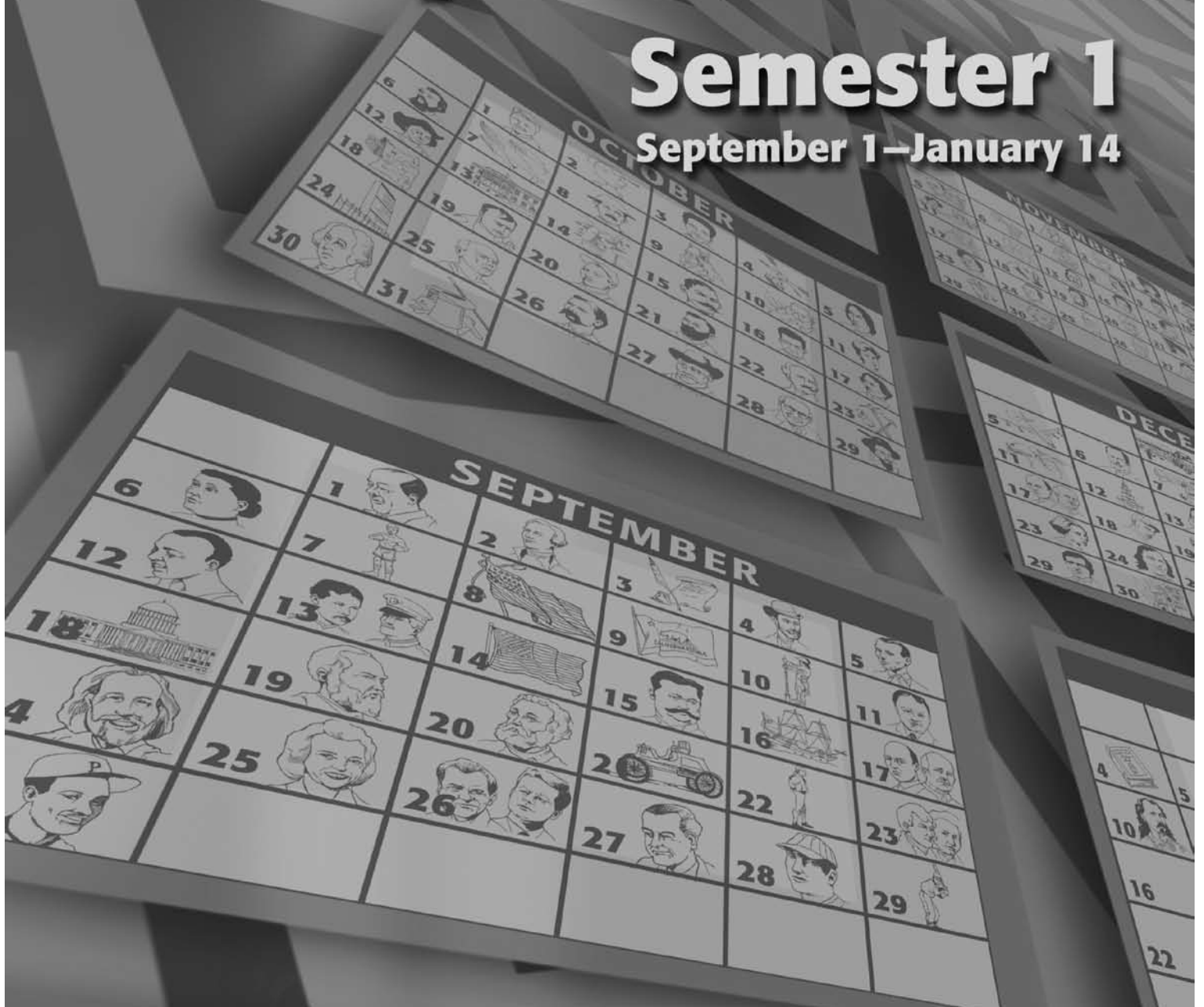

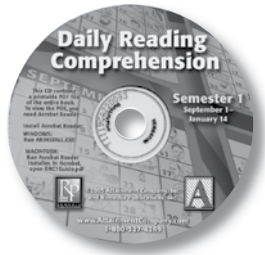

## INTRODUCTION

*Daily Reading Comprehension* is a three-volume series featuring an on-this-day-in-history approach. A short, factual story about a person, place, or event is presented for each day of the month and was chosen because of its particular significance on that date.

With stories for each day of the school year, *Daily Reading Comprehension* books present high interest, low readability stories at the 3rd to 4th grade reading levels. Each story is accompanied by an activity page which tests student comprehension of the article's content. The activities allow students to practice skills like reading for details, locating information, finding facts and improving vocabulary. Activity page formats vary to maintain student interest, using word pyramids, crossword puzzles, fill-in-the-blanks and true/false questions. A related research option for each story encourages students to use a dictionary, atlas or encyclopedia to gather additional information.

*Daily Reading Comprehension* books are arranged by date: *Semester 1* takes students from September through January 14; *Semester 2* continues from January 15 through May 31; *Summer* includes June through August.
