


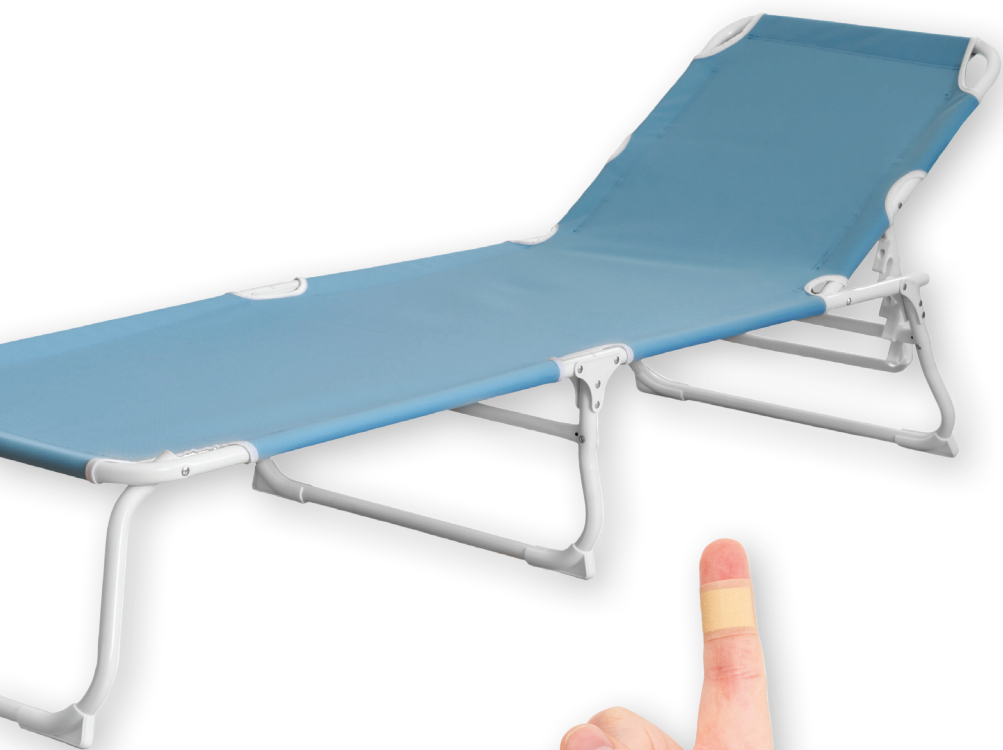

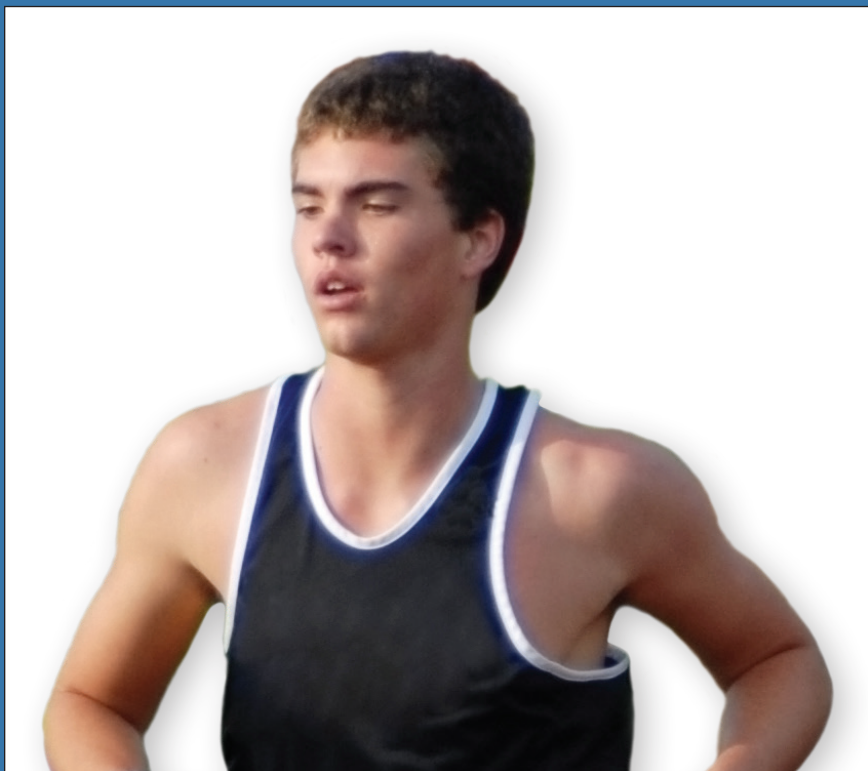

Dad says, "Do you want pine or oak?" "Oak," says Ty. They get oak from the shed.



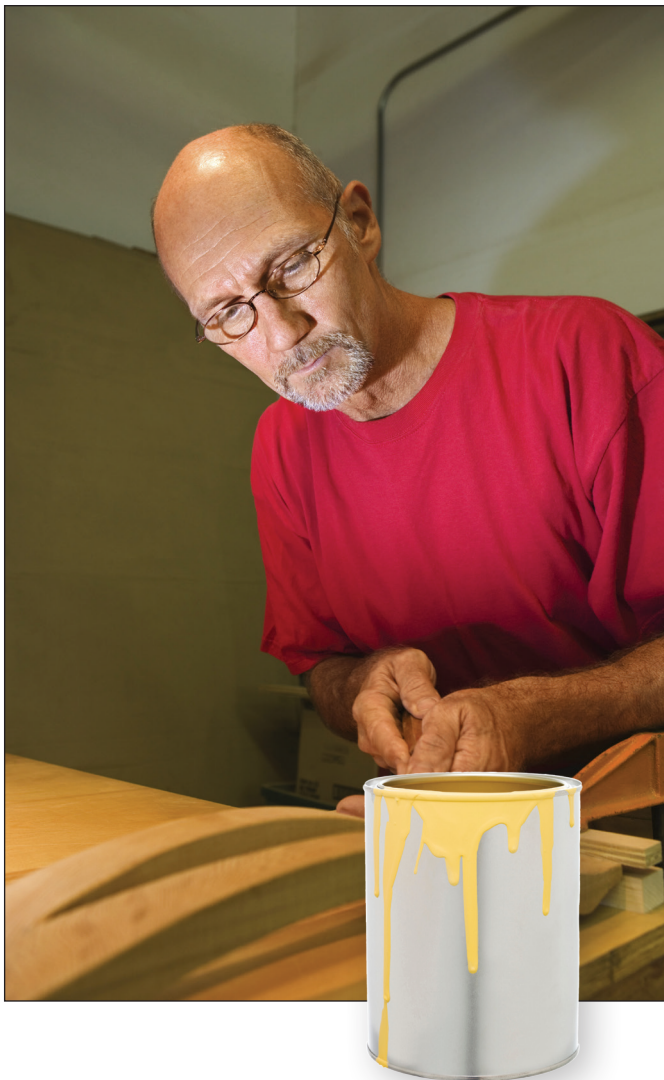
**Ty hits a nail into the oak,

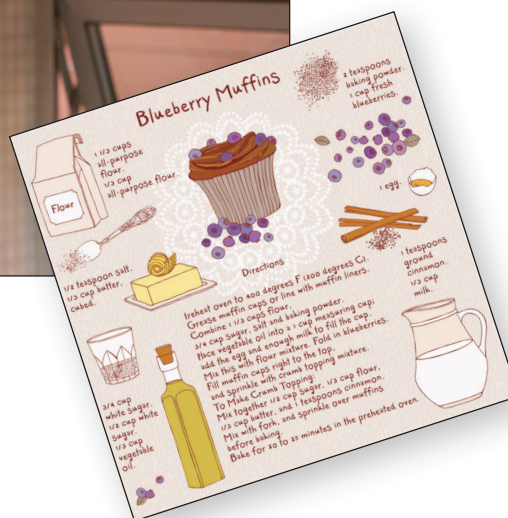
A Dinner Plan Gets Messy
